Design an effective introduction Engage the audience — get them interested, give them a reason to listen. How? Describe a scene or a character. Tell a story. Share a personal experience. Relate to a recent event. Piggyback on a previous speaker's remark or theme.

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1. Make It Meaningful In aiming for full engagement, it is essential that students perceive activities as being meaningful. Research has shown that if students do not consider a learning activity worthy of their time and effort, they might not engage in a satisfactory way, or may even disengage entirely in response (Fredricks, Blumenfeld, & Paris, 2004).
